June 21 REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING (third Thursday of the month) at
Thursday UNM Physics/Astronomy Building, 7:30 p.m.

John N. Durrie will show slides of birds of New Mexico and also some of the birds of Florida which were taken on a recent trip. Mr. Durrie is perhaps our senior member -- not in age, but in years of membership. He has had a lifelong interest in birds and joined National Audubon in 1921, when he was a little boy. He has belonged ever since. In recent years he has taken up bird photography as an extension of his interest.
